- Sell A Minimum 20 \$109 Cool Cat Student Passes & Your SAU/ School Will Receive A Rebate Of \$10 For Every Pass Sold
- SAU or Collective Educational Contact Person Will Receive Free Adult Season Pass
- Available for Every New England School, Public, Private, or Educational Collective

### Wildcat Mountain Facts:

- 4,062' summit; 1,950' base; 2,112 vertical foot drop
- 25% beginner, 45% intermediate, 30% expert
- Polecat Trail is longest beginner trail in NH
- Wildcat Jib Lot with boxes and rails
- Wildcat receives the most natural snow of any New Hampshire ski area and is often the last resort open in late April/early May
- The Wildcat Express summit quad is the most powerful lift in New England



## The 2009/2010 COOL CAT Student Winter Season Ski/Ride Pass & Fundraiser Program Coordinator F.A.Q's

- (Q) I am interested in a Wildcat Mountain free 2009/2010 season pass, helping to raise funds for my school, and being a Cool Cat Coordinator Contact for my SAU or private school/educational institution, what does it involve? (A) To be eligible, you must coordinate distributing Cool Cat season pass information to the school(s) and being available to answer questions when necessary. You must also collect the minimum 20 orders, be sure payment and liability forms are included, and submit collectively by indicated deadline dates.
- (Q) Who is eligible to purchase a Cool Cat student season pass? (A) All students within a SAU or private school/educational institution are eligible to purchase a \$109 Cool Cat Student 2009/2010 winter season pass.
- (Q) Who do the check payments get made to? (A) All checks or money orders must be made out to 'Wildcat Mountain Ski Area, Inc' and attached to order form when collective orders are submitted.
- (Q) When do I have to send collected season pass orders in by? (A) The Coordinating contact person must collect orders (including a signed parent liability form & attached payment) from parents/students and collectively submit orders to Wildcat Mountain before November 1st in order for season passes to be processed before scheduled opening day. Orders collectively submitted after November 1st and received no later than December 1st will not be processed until December 15th and students will not be able to ski or ride until that time.
- (Q) I am the SAU or collective educational contact, when will my school or organization receive the \$10 rebate for every season pass sold? (A) The rebate amount will be totaled after all collective season pass orders have been processed and all payments have cleared. Within 30 days from that time, Wildcat Mountain will send a check for the total amount to the SAU Superintendent's or collective educational office. It will be the responsibility of Superintendent's or private school/educational institution's administration office to distribute funds to individual schools or organizations.
- (Q) I'm a Cool Cat Coordinator Contact, when do I get my season pass? (A) Contact persons should fill out and include a season pass order form for the complimentary pass and include a signed liability form when they submit the minimum 20 student pass orders. The complimentary pass will be issued when student passes have been processed and all payments have cleared.
- (Q) Can I assign my complimentary season pass to someone other than me? (A) Yes, complete and submit the complimentary pass order as you would for yourself, but write the person's name and information and include their signed liability form when minimum 20 student pass orders are submitted.
